The Data Protection programme covers the fundamental concepts and principles of data protection, data subject rights, data protection policies and measures, and regulatory compliance.

A breach in personal data security can have serious personal consequences for individuals, as well as legal and commercial consequences for organisations.

Employers are increasingly valuing the knowledge of data protection concepts. This programme applies to organisations both inside and outside the European Union.

Students will receive an ICDL Certification upon passing the assessment.
